THE STREET STORE is an initiative organised and supported by various churches, businesses and schools, joining hands to host a free popup clothing store to bless people in need.

Here, low-income communities can come and freely choose clothing items they like in a dignifying manner.

Not only are the shoppers provided with clothing, but each shopper is also welcomed with something to eat and invited to connect with the volunteers who serve and usher them with intentional care.

A Girl Project serves teenage girls by providing sanitary products, while a prayer team hands out Bibles and prays with people in a heartfelt and purposeful way.

The mission of Street Store is to unite different churches to make a collective impact in the city — blessing people with clothing, bringing hope, restoring dignity, and relieving some of life's hardships.

FEEDBACK

- This year, Street Store united 10 churches to provide warm meals and clothing to those in need ahead of the harsh Free State winter.

- It also marked the 10th anniversary of Street Store in Bloemfontein, celebrated across two sites: Anchor of Hope in Hamilton and Heidedal Primary School in Heidedal.
- Through the combined efforts of faithful donors and volunteers, churches stood side by side to serve their community with love and compassion.
- At the Anchor of Hope site; Doxa Deo North, VEK Kerugma, Baptist Church, and NG Uitsig Gemeente joined forces, with more than 350 volunteers humbly serving over 1,500 people.
- Together with the Heidedal site, nearly 2,700 people received help on 17 May 2025.
