- **An anti-racism program for the junior phase at one of our schools**

This powerful initiative is rooted in the truth that every person is made in the image of God. It teaches children to view diversity through the eyes of Jesus and to love others equally. It is a step toward creating more inclusive and Christ-centred school environments.



- **Our UCSA Week in Hoopstad**

This was a first for TREE! We had the incredible opportunity to bless another city for an entire week, serving teachers and learners in various ways. It was a deeply impactful time of ministry and outreach.

- **Our consistent involvement at Hoërskool Sentraal**

One of our greatest victories this year has been the sustained and growing spiritual impact at Sentraal. The school allowed us to place a youth worker on-site every Thursday. This consistent presence has provided ongoing guidance and support and opened new doors for additional ministry opportunities, including prayer hours, evening hostel ministry, UCSA Weeks, and Open-Air events.

These initiatives have significantly expanded our reach and deepened our role in the spiritual life of the school.
