The TREE team at Fichardtpark High School consists of Edcyn Kok, Christie-Lee van Aardt, and Christo Fourie. They are responsible for the spiritual leadership of learners through UCSA and for leadership development once a month.

TREE primarily offers teachings in the school hall, accompanied by worship and games. The school leaders are then equipped to present these teachings to the rest of the school during the week.

TREE also takes responsibility for equipping at the beginning of the year in the form of a camp, which has been running faithfully for years.

Impact in Numbers

- An estimate of 60–70 learners are impacted per week each term.
- During UCSA Week, we reach between 850–900 learners per day.
- In the first and second term TREE had five engagements with the school (excluding the VCSV Camp), and three engagements during the third term.

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VICTORIES

- This year, we've seen learners not only come to salvation but also start serving in the school as UCSA leaders.
- This is a strong indication of discipleship taking root in their lives.
- UCSA Week was held in the Doxa Deo South Church auditorium in order to overcome technical constraints and provide ample seating to ensure that the teens had an excellent experience.
- We received many testimonies of how much both the teens and teachers enjoyed it.

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Vision for 2026

We have a pressing need for the Gospel to come alive. The teens seem to know a lot about God, but this knowledge doesn't always translate into action. While they may have amazing personal revelations, their impact on others remains limited.

Looking ahead to 2026, we want to create opportunities for teens to live out the Gospel in love—finding highly practical ways to serve one another and their community.

We also want the teachers at the school to experience their jobs as a calling, not just as a way to make ends meet, but as an opportunity to raise the next generation.

Furthermore, we aim to provide them with practical tools to help them navigate both life and the pressures of school.
