## MIRACLE HOUSE

THE MIRACLE HOUSE in Bloemfontein, led by Boeta Swart of Anchor of Hope, is nearly ready to open as **a refuge for single mothers and children**. The home will accommodate 16 families, allowing them to live together until the children finish school.

The project began when someone generously donated a house, sparking a story of faith, provision, and community support. Numerous individuals and partner organizations supported and contributed which made the renovations and preparations possible.

The Miracle House is more than a building—it is a safe, nurturing space where hope, love, and growth can flourish.

## A STORY OF MIRACLES

- When Anchor of Hope took ownership last year, Boeta faced the daunting task of renovating the house without any funds in place. But God's hand was evident every step of the way.
- A Christian contractor agreed to start the work with the promise of eventual payment, while prayer and Scripture guided every decision. At one pivotal moment, a friend was moved by Psalm 96, which in Afrikaans is titled For Young Women, giving Boeta confirmation to move forward.

- Miracles continued to unfold: a local company offered to cover all labour costs if materials could be secured, prompting the team to reach out across the community for donations.
- When funds ran low, Boeta received a Scripture about getting help from abroad—and that very day a woman from Australia, who had seen their project on Facebook, offered support. Even a need for 12 showers was miraculously met when a local glass company volunteered to sponsor them.
- Today, the house is almost ready to open, with only cupboards left to install. Boeta shares that the shelter will enable Anchor of Hope to support families throughout the cycle of life, from pregnancy through school years, providing a place where mothers can find hope, employment support, and their children can access quality education.
