Our weekly TREE engagement at Tjokkies Primary School involves a team of five individuals.

We have a host who facilitates the program for the day; this includes an icebreaker, as well as opening and closing in prayer.

We have a presenter who teaches a child-friendly, Bible-focused, Christ-centred lesson for 15–20 minutes.

The rest of the team consists of a tech-support person who handles all media, along with a team or individual who facilitates worship. Worship is either done live or through video worship songs.

This takes place during a hall period on Wednesday mornings from 11:00–12:00 and involves the entire senior group (Grades 4–7).

Each week, we minister to approximately 200–400 children.
