Week Three – Discovering Your Unique Role.

The DISC personality test is a popular assessment tool that categorizes people's behaviour into four primary personality traits:

Dominance (D), Influence (I), Steadiness (S), and Conscientiousness (C).



Dominance (D): *Individuals with a high D trait are typically assertive, results-oriented, and driven by challenges. They focus on getting things done quickly and are often seen as leaders who enjoy taking control of situations.*

Influence (I): *Those with a high I trait are usually sociable, outgoing, and enthusiastic. They thrive on interacting with others, motivating people, and bringing energy to group activities. They value collaboration and enjoy influencing others to achieve common goals.*

Steadiness (S): *People with a high S trait are patient, reliable, and supportive. They tend to be good listeners, valuing harmony and stability in their environment. They prefer to work at a steady pace and are often focused on building and maintaining strong relationships.*

Conscientiousness (C): *Individuals with a high C trait are detail-oriented, analytical, and precise. They are focused on accuracy, quality, and following rules and procedures. They excel in tasks that require careful planning and attention to detail.*

THEME FOR THE WEEK:

This week, we focus on discovering the unique role that God has given you in His grand narrative. You are not just an extra in the play of life but have a specific role crafted by the Creator Himself.

INTRODUCTION:

We are now at Week 3 of our journey. You have discovered that God wants to restore humanity and the earth. Last week, we learned how we can fulfil God's presence on earth. In this session, we begin to focus more on your role within God's plan.

START THE CONVERSATION:

(What question do we want to answer in this session?)

Q: *What comes to mind when you think about the unique gifts or passions God has given you? How have these shaped your understanding of your purpose?*

WHAT IS IT ALL ABOUT?

1. Discovering "Who You Are" (Personality and Values):

Understanding who you are is the first step in discovering your role in God's plan. Consider how your personality and values influence your actions and decisions.

Q: *How does your personality (whether a "D, I, S, or C") shape the way you serve in God's Kingdom?*

Q: *What values do you hold dear, and how do they reflect God's presence in your life?*

2. Understanding Your Passion:

Your passions are often indicators of where God might be calling you to make a difference. Reflect on what excites or burdens you.

Q: *What passions has God placed on your heart? How might these be leading you to your unique role in His story?*

Q: *How do the things that move your heart align with the needs in your community or the world?*

3. Identifying Your Abilities:

Jesus emphasizes the importance of using the gifts and talents He has given us to further His Kingdom.

Q: *How have your life experiences and talents equipped you to serve others?*

Q: *In what ways do you see your abilities as a reflection of God's plan for you?*

LIFE APPLICATION:

Reflect on your life experiences. How have these shaped your understanding of your personality, passions, and abilities? Write down one action step you can take this week to begin living out your unique role in God's plan.

PRAY TOGETHER:

Spend time in prayer, asking God to reveal more about who He has created you to be. Invite the Holy Spirit to guide you as you discover and live out your unique role in God's Kingdom.
