**Q:** *In what ways do you see your personal mission contributing to the good works God has prepared for you (**Ephesians 2:10**)?*

## **LIFE APPLICATION:**

**Self-Reflection:** *How does your personality, passion, and skill set guide your sense of purpose?*

**Action Plan:** *Take time this week to write down your life mission statement. Make sure it reflects who you are, what you value, and how you want to contribute to God's Kingdom.*

**Group Sharing:** *If you're in a group, share your drafted mission statement and discuss the process of creating it. Offer feedback and encouragement to each other.*
